



Collaging Tips

DO NOT trace the inside of the frame assuming it will be the same size as your card.



DO trace the actual card you will glue to.

- Combine and overlap with a separate image to connect, or
- Find a color that blends in, or
- Stack to make one.



You can also use "negative" space.
